Thesis B Demo Assessment Components

There are three assessment components:

- 1. Technical quality and completeness of the work (80%) Contents assessed: progress against the plan
- 2. Revised plan (10%)
 - Contents assessed: feasibility and completeness of the detailed plan for Thesis C
- 3. Structure and delivery of the presentation (10%)
 Contents assessed: presentation structure and delivery quality

Your demo should follow the following structure:

- 1. Descriptions of your project.
- 2. Your plan for Thesis B given in your Thesis A report.
- 3. Detailed progress report. Explain your results for Thesis B obtained so far.
- 4. Use a table to summarise all the tasks that you planned in Thesis A report to complete in Thesis B and explain which tasks have been completed and which tasks have not been completed. The main purpose of this component is to make assessors easier to assess your demo.
- 5. A revised plan for the rest of thesis work in Thesis C.
